I was born in England where my involvement with Staffords started with my father Eric Humphrey. Growing up my dad always said no to a dog until he could get a Staffordshire Bull Terrier. One day he did get one. Our first was a black brindle male officially called Black King or 'Skipper'. Bob Salisbury talked my father into showing him. Black King went on to get a Reserved CC and also sired CH Black Tusker. My love of Staffords continued when I moved to Canada in 1970. A year later I got a male Staff from my dad called CH Can. Am. CD Pride of Black King or 'Skip'. I went on to show Skip both here and in the States when we were recognized along with a female called Can. Am. CD Monkhill Jubilee or 'Kim'. I also competed in obedience with them, getting their Companion Dog titles in both Canada and the States. I enjoyed obedience more and continued in that sport with all my Staffies. Over the years I've had a number of other Staffies who also participated in Flyball. I bred Staffords under the kennel name Jubilee Reg'd.

Since the breed ban was put in place in 2005, I have had to stop breeding, but have continued to show the two female Staffies we've owned since the ban was put in place in Ontario. The first, CH Distaff Jubilee's Gem or 'Gem' became a Canadian Champion after the ban took place. The second Zoey was also shown but didn't title. Gem has gone over the bridge but Zoey still greets me at the door looking for Timbits whenever I go out.

I am currently a life member of the Canadian Kennel Club and the Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Canada. I have been Treasurer for the Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Canada for a number of years and am continuing as Treasurer for this term.
